

How do I get the authcode to transfer my domain?

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A transfer authorization code a.k.a. EPP code is required when transferring any domain name from one registrar to another. The transfer authorization code is created at the time of registration and can be obtained from the current registrar for the domain.

If you have a domain registered through Webservio, you can obtain this code at any time. The procedures for each system are below. If you are not sure which system to use, please review the article: [Which system do I use to manage my domain registered with Webservio?](#)

***The authcode will be emailed to the Admin Contact on file for the domain. Before requesting the code, make sure that this is an email address you have access to. To change this address, refer to:

Obtain Authcode via Webservio Billing

- » Log into your account at <https://billing.webservio.net/clientarea.php>
- » On the top toolbar, select Domains and click on My Domains.
- » To the right of the domain you wish to transfer, select the wrench icon dropdown menu and click on Manage Domain.
- » On the left side menu, click on Get EPP Code. This will email the code to the Admin Contact for the domain.

Obtain Authcode via services.webservio.net

- » Log into your account at <http://services.webservio.net/login.php>
- » Hover over the Welcome message at the top of the page and click on My Account.
- » Hover over Manage Orders and click on List/Search Orders
- » Click the domain that you wish to transfer.
- » Click Domain Secret. The pop-up window will display the authcode.

Obtain Authcode via OpenSRS

- » Log into your account at <https://manage.opensrs.net>
- » Click on Domain Extras
- » The screen will display the authcode.
