

How to create an SMTP Connector in Exchange 2003

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To create the SMTP Connector, follow the steps below:

- » Open Exchange System Manager (ESM)
- » If **Administrative Groups** is displayed, expand the Administrative Groups folder (Otherwise proceed to step 4)
- » Expand **First Administrative Group** (or the relevant group if it has been renamed or if there are multiple groups)
- » If **Routing Groups** is displayed, expand the Routing Groups folder (Otherwise proceed to step 6)
- » Expand **First Routing Group**
- » Right click **Connectors**
- » Select **New** then **SMTP Connector...**

»
Enter a descriptive name for the new connector. For example, SpamWeeder Premium Connector (1).

»
Select **Forward all mail through this connector...**

» Enter outbound1.spamweeder.mailshelter.com (the SpamWeeder Premium service address) into the **Smart Hosts** field.

» Under Local Bridgeheads, select the **Add...** button.
» Select the appropriate Exchange server from the list.Â This will generally be the Exchange server you are working on. Click the **OK** button (which will be enabled once a server has been selected):

» Click the **Apply** button to save the SMTP Connector Properties.

» Select the **Address Space** tab:

» Click the **Add...** button:

» Click the **OK** button
» Select **SMTP** as the **Address Type**
» Keep the default values given:

Email domain = *
Cost = 1

» Click the **OK** button twice to complete the creation of your SMTP connector.
